Daily Itinerary

DAY 1 Fly to Iceland from the United States today

DAY 2 Arrive Keflavik Airport KEF (23 km, 20 minutes) - Blue Lagoon

Arrive at Keflavik International Airport in Iceland in the morning. Walking out of the Keflavik International Airport in Iceland, you will be greeted by a volcanic rock formation full of fantasy colors that feels like you are in the moon. We will take the bus through the rolling volcanic rock

Hotel: Fosshotel Reykjavik (4-Star) or similar

DAY 3 Reykjavik Reykjavik (90 km, 1 hour 10 minutes) – Thingvellir (60 km, 45 minutes) - Golden Circle (65 km, 50 minutes Selfoss)

- Thigvellir National Park: Today's first stop Thingvellir National Park a UNESCO World Heritage Site, this is where you enjoy the scenery and learn about the history of Iceland. Our guides are familiar and knowledgeable on many aspects of the park, that certainly add more fun to your visit.
- Kerid Crater Lake: A 3,000-year-old extinct volcano. After the last eruption, the volcano collapsed to form the crater. This is one of a popular tourist attraction in Iceland.
- Tomato Village: The farm featuring the effort of how the local farmers overcome the harsh weather of Iceland and successfully grow the vegetables locally.
- Geysir Geothermal Area: It has hundreds of colorful hot springs and two geysers. A geyser named "Geyser" most of the geysers in the world were named after it. Today, however, it rarely erupts. Another geyser, called "Strokur", erupts every 5 minutes and reaches a height of 40 meters.
- Golden Falls: Melting ice from Langjkur, Iceland's second largest glacier, falls through a deep valley and form the majestic "Golden Falls". On a sunny and clear day, you are able to see you can see the glacier Langecourt in the distance and with a rainbow in the mist of the waterfall.

DAY 4 Selfoss (145 km, 1 hour 45 minutes) - Vik (60 km, 45 minutes) - Orefi Hnappavellir

The south coast of Iceland has beautiful scenery, and major famous scenic spots are concentrated over here. We will spend two full days here to fully experience the changing scenery of the South Bank.

- Skoga Falls, is as charming as Seljalandfoss Falls. The two waterfalls are about the same height, about 60 meters, but Skoga Falls is wider (approximately 25 meters in width) and formed by glacial melting ice from the eponymous ice cap (Eyjafjallajökull) on the famous Eyjafjallajökull volcano. It is also the starting point of Iceland's famous hiking trail, Fimmvörðuháls The starting point of the island's famous hiking trail, Fimmvörðuháls.
- Vik Town Next stop, we will come to the black sand beach of Reynisfjara next to the town of Vik. The black sand beach is glowing with black luster and is mercilessly beaten by the fierce waves of the North Atlantic, highlighting the power of the sea. Standing here looking at the view of , looking at the Reynisdrangar stone pillars and the rolling waves, it almost feels like the end of the world.

DAY 5 Orefi Hnappavellir (30 km, 25 minutes) - Jokulsarlon Glacier Lagoon

TJökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon: The glacial lake is deep, and there are many enormous icebergs floating on the lake. Talking about the tip of the iceberg, imagine that there is an enormous iceberg ten times bigger in size hidden under the lake, you just have to admire the magic of nature. When the light is dim, the floes reflect the lights, which is particularly moving. If you are lucky enough to see the iceberg flip, you will see the deepest and brightest color of ice blue.

- Glacier Lagoon Cruise (May-October): Take an amphibious boat, shuttle between giant ice blocks, enjoy the famous ice scenery of the Glacier Lake, and experience a world of ice.
- Diamond Beach: On the black sand beach where the lake meets the sea, ice cubes of various sizes and shapes are stranded on the beach, looking like shining diamonds.

DAY 6 Orefi Hnappavellir (270 km, 3 hours 30 minutes) - Selfoss

Vatnajökull Hike (May-September): Embark on an unforgettable journey on the glacier tongue of Vatnajökull. 1-1.5 hour hike (participation fee \$65).

- Moss Garden: The largest lava garden in the world, its eruption in 1783 shook the world.
- Dyrhólaey : Go to Iceland's southernmost lighthouse and admire the majestic sea stone pillars.

Hotel: Hotel South Coast (4-Star) or similar

DAY 7 Selfoss (70 km, 1 hour) - Reykjavik

Take the bus to Reykjavik, the northernmost capital in the world.

• Hallgrim Church: Inspired by basalt lava columns, you can see from the top of the top, in addition to a bird's-eye view of the city, you can also see Esja, Akrafjall and Keilir in the distance, and if the sky is clear, you can even see Sniffy at a glance Glacier.

Capital Hot Water Supply Company, also known as Reykjavik. It is the landmark buildings in Reykjavik. There are hot spring models, exhibition halls, restaurants, etc. in the building. Visitors can view the city through the telescope installed on the observation deck. It is also the best place to enjoy the view of the whole city.
