DAY 1 USA international airport $\overline{\chi}$ to Lisbon , Portugal

DAY 2 Lisbon

The flight arrived this morning in Haicheng - Lisbon is known as the "European countryside."

Taste authentic Portuguese 100-year-old egg tarts with coffee.

Stroll through the Belém district: Belém Tower, Monument to the Discoveries, Jerónimos Monastery

Santa Justa Terrace: A perfect combination of Lisbon's skyline and ancient city buildings

São Jorge Castle: Overlooking Lisbon and the wide Tygas River

DAY 3 Lisbon - Sintra - Cape Loca - Lisbon

English poet Byron wrote about "Eden on Earth": the district of Canda and visit the Pena Palace, a World Heritage Fairytale Palace

Cape Loca overlooks the Atlantic Ocean: the end of the world, the beginning of the ocean, and a "proof of Europe's westernmost point", worthy of permanent memories and treasures.

Lisbon Sightseeing: A Century-Old Nostalgic Tram

DAY 4 Lisbon - Merida - Sevilla

Head to Mérida, the city of ancient Roman ruins, which retains many Roman ruins, giving it the nickname "Little

Rome", the ★ Guadiana River Bridge ★ Amphitheater (Oval Arena)

The capital of Andalusia, Spain & the capital of the 1992 World's Fair - Seville

Taste Iberian ham and Iberian pork chops paired with a selection of award-winning wines, selected from the Iberian Pig region, one of the world's most gourmet cuisines

DAY 5 Seville

Metropolitan Parasol: The world's largest wooden structure in Encarnacion, Spain, it holds up a giant parasol for the residents of the small town, under which are museums, shopping malls, restaurants and observation decks.

Visit the Cathedral of Sevia, the third largest in the world.

Climb the Girada Tower to overlook the city streets.

Visit the Alcazar palace with it's illamic cultural style

Maria Luisa Park, the Golden Tower, the most Muslim Holy Cross Jewish Quarter

Ride a horse-drawn carriage through the beautiful and romantic streets of Seville.

DAY 6 Seville - Andalusia White Town - Ronda

Stroll through the white town of Andalusia and indulge in the tranquility and purity of the old town.

The birthplace of bullfighting: Ronda, full of white walls and a new bridge suspended 100 meters above the ground, forming a peculiar sightseeing scene.

Spain's oldest and most beautiful "Ronda Bullring"

In the evening, enjoy the sunset as the "Ronda Cliff" falls on the rolling mountains.

DAY 7 Ronda - Bovadilla - Granada

The last Muslim dynasty in Spain, Granada, was a place of rest for Muslim forces, so it also retained a strong

Islamic color.

DAY 8 Granada - Cordoba

Visit the Alhambra Castle District, which is of great artistic value and described as a "paradise on earth": the Palazzo District, the Palace of Charles V, the "Garden of Paradise" the Gardens of the Royal Court of Genarife

In the evening, you can walk through the Hundred Flowers Alley in the Cordoba Jewish Quarter, step over the 2,000-year-old Roman Bridge, and look at the Masjid on the other side.

DAY 9 Cordoba - Consuegra - Toledo

MEZQUITA Islamic masjid: A strange hybrid of Islamic and Renaissance architecture, the interior is decorated with 850 onyx jasper-like marble columns, which makes you feel like entering a labyrinth, and is the only mosque in the world that is a wonder.

White Windmill Village: A white windmill that has stood on a hill for more than 400 years, a giant in the eyes of Don Quixote, written by the Spanish literary magnate Cervantes.

Known as the city of the 16th century - Toledo: enjoy a meal in the best view of the restaurant while watching the sunset cast a golden veil over the ancient city.

DAY 10 Toledo-Madrid

Madrid, the capital of Spain, take a tour of the Spanish capital.

Columbus Square, Fountain of Sibelius

Casa Batby: Gaudi in Barcelona's perfect natural architecture

Park Güell: Step into a fantasy world created by the genius Gaudí and immerse yourself in fantastic fairytale architecture.

Sagrada Familia: The only unfinished building in the world to be listed as a World Heritage Site, a natural dream forest built in paradise.

Montjuïc Hill, National Palace MNAC: View of Barcelona Port from the Hill Feel the unique charm of Barcelona.
