DAY 1 LAX - Barcelona, Spain

DAY 2 Arrives in Barcelona

Arrive at Barcelona International Airport, where your guide will be picked up by our driver and transferred to hotel to rest. (Only one pick-up is included at the same timing. Guests arriving at other times are requested to go to the hotel by themselves)

DAY 3 Barcelona

Parc Güell (admission included): Park Güell is a fine example of garden design among Gaudi's many works. The man-made landscape here looks more natural than the natural landscape, and the use of color and line is also used to the extreme. A walk through the park is a great way to immerse yourself in realism, and you'll also see the whole city from the height of the park.

Sagrada Família (ticket included): a masterpiece by the talented artist Gaudí, not only listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, but also a sacred place for many tourists. The three facades of the church are presented in a grand and coordinated manner, with clean lines, reliefs on the walls of the church doors showing the story of the Bible, like living creatures, and the design of the interior of the church inspired by caves, mountains, flowers and animals adds a mysterious rhythm to the church.

La Pedrera: The wavy exterior is made up of white stone facades, twisted iron bars and iron balustrades, and wide windows that allow the imagination to be used.

La Rambla is one of the most well-known shopping streets in Barcelona and one of the sightseeing spots in Barcelona that many tourists will surely put on their agenda.

DAY 4 Barcelona - AVE high-speed train (2nd class) - Madrid

Royal Palace of Madrid (ticket included): The Royal Palace, also known as the Palais de l'Oriente, is no longer the residence of the royal family, but it is still the main place where the king receives state guests. The architecture of the Royal Palace combines traditional Spanish royal architecture and Baroque architecture, with a square shape, each side is 180 meters long, and is made of white granite.

DAY 5 Madrid - Toledo - Granada Granada

Toledo is located on a hill about 70 kilometers south of Madrid, is a beautiful medieval ancient city, in the 11th~16th century was the capital of the Kingdom of Castile, but also the political, cultural and economic center of Spain at that time, thousands of years of baptism, so that every stone here has its own story.

Granada: Alhambra Palace and Generalife (ticket included) is a mesmerizing palace that feels like you're in a fantasy

DAY 6 Granada - Cordoba - Seville, Seville

The evolution of the history of Le Mezquita (ticket included) has made the mosque a mix of Christian and Muslim architecture, with 19 facades on the exterior and 850 agate jasper-like marble columns on the inside.

DAY 7 Seville - Lisbon

Seville Cathedral and Catedral (admission included) are the third largest in the world after St. Peter's Basilica in Rome and St. Paul's Church in London

The semicircular square of Mraia Luisa Park (inside) is famous for its colourful tiles plastered with Spanish history

DAY 8 Lisbon

DAY 9 Lisbon + Marrakesh

[Reference Flight: 2:40P/4:20P]

Arrive at Marrakech International Airport and visit the exterior Koutoubiya Mosque, a landmark of Marrakech with an incredible piece of history.

Then visit Bahia Palace (admission included), one of the few royal palaces in Morocco that is open to the public and preserved by Marriott, with gardens, atriums, ornate rooms, fountains, each room carefully designed. The size of the rooms was designed according to the favor of the king's wives, but each wife's room had its own atrium.

After dinner, head to Jemaael-Fna, the largest open-air square in Morocco. From sunrise until late at night, you can see Indian snake dancers, Arabs selling spiced tea, old Moroccans telling stories and fortunes, various performances, and countless stalls selling food, drinks, clothing, carpets, furnishings, leather, and handicrafts. It is like Lan Kwai Fong in Hong Kong and Xintiandi in Shanghai, because of this square, Marrakech has infinite vitality. We can choose to experience a variety of snacks and freshly squeezed juices in the square, or we can enjoy the panoramic view of the square in the sunset from the nearby viewing café.

* Reminder: the sleepless square is bustling, pay attention to your valuables, and ignore anyone who close up casually. If you want to buy something, be sure to negotiate the price and the currency of the price to avoid unnecessary trouble.

DAY 10 Marrakech - Ouarzazate

Visit Jardin Majorelle (admission included), a private garden that the famous costume designer Yves Saint Laurent bought with his partner Pierre Berge in Marrakech, Morocco. The bright blue of the courtyard fills the exterior of the building, light and shadow play in the carved panes, palms, cacti and other tropical plants grow from the sand and gravel soil towards the sun, and the Islamic style decoration carries a strong Moroccan style.

After lunch, drive for about 4 and a half hours to the village of Ebunhadu. Visit the village of Ait-Ben-Haddou (ticket included), an ancient Berber city in southern Morocco that was an important gateway in ancient times, exceptionally well preserved and inhabited by the natives, and was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1987. The ancient city is built using terracotta mud bricks unique to Morocco, allowing people to fully experience the red charm of Morocco.

Then drive about 40 minutes to Ouarzazate in Ouarzazate is home to the largest studio in Morocco (admission included), a city full of world cultural sites, and rich history that is known as Mollywood.

DAY 11 Quarazate - Merzouga

A 3-hour drive to the Dardès Gorge. In the first century AD, King Anu, ruler of ancient Iberia, named the Dadais River, which originates high in the Atlas Mountains, and the rock walls near the river form a colorful natural canyon landscape from 200 meters to 500 meters. After dinner, drive 3 hours to the desert edge city of Ilfourd, which serves as a stopover into the desert. We will take a 4WD to the Mezzurca Desert (Around 1-hour drive).

Choose your own desert activities: ride a dromedary unique North Africa through the desert, and quietly stroll on the Sahara Desert under the afterglow of the sunset to enjoy the beauty of the Sahara Desert; Or hop aboard a handsome sand buggy ride over rolling sand dunes for sweeping views of the Sahara.

*Reminder: When entering the desert, you can prepare a scarf as a prop for taking photos, and also play a role in shielding the wind and sand.

DAY 12 Merzouga - Fes

4WD vehicles drive from the desert to Erfoud for a coach. Driving all day to Fez, known as one of Morocco's four ancient imperial cities, we enter the Atlas Mountains region, where the beautiful valley scenery rivals the Grand Canyon of the United States. Arrive in Medirt for lunch.

After that, we came to the small town of Eveland, located in the Atlas Mountains at an altitude of 1664 meters, 60 kilometers south of Feis, which began to be founded in 1929 and is a small town with a population of only about 10,000 people, attracting countless tourists to vacation here every year. There is no trace of Moroccan culture here.

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In the evening, arrive at the ancient city of Fez, ranked by the famous American magazine (Traveler) as one of the 10 most romantic cities in the world.

DAY 13 Fes - Chefchaouen

Enter the ancient city of Fez and travel back a thousand years to a thousand years ago, where donkeys were still the main means of transportation for the common people, and visit the old medieval old town: Bou Inania medersas (admission included), Nejjarine Spring (exterior), Idris Mausoleum (builder of the ancient capital) (exterior) and the world's first university, Calaviyne University (exterior), the gate of the Andalu Mosque (exterior), the honeycomb nest handmade leather dyeing workshop in the ancient city. Fez is the cultural centre of Morocco and the old town was officially declared a World Heritage Site in 1981. Come to the observation deck high outside the city, overlooking the entire old city, as if admiring a living picture of the Qingming River. After lunch, drive to the blue and white town of Chefchaouen.

DAY 14 Chefchouen - Casablanca

Drive to Casablanca and visit the world's most modern Hassan II mosque La Mosquee Hassan II (admission included), it is the third largest mosque in the Islamic world, with a construction area of 2 hectares, 200 meters long, 100 meters wide, a roof that can be opened and closed, 25 automatic doors all cast from titanium, resistant to seawater corrosion, and the marble floor in the temple is heated all year round, making it the most modern mosque in the world. Visit Mohammed V Square, Hassan II Square (Piazza dove), stroll the Casablanca Miami Corniche and enjoy the sea breeze and the blue Atlantic Ocean. After lunch, drive to Marrakech.

*Reminder: to enter the Hassan II Mosque, there are no special requirements in terms of clothing, no need to wrap a headscarf, no need to wear an Arabic robe, try not to wear revealing clothing, enter the visit, just take off your shoes on the floor of the worship hall. When taking photos, do not make exaggerated movements, actions that are not in line with religion.

DAY 15 Casablanca + LAX
