DAY 1 USA->Kansai International Airport

DAY 2 Kansai International Airport - Kobe

Guests will be greeted at the airport lobby with the sonic tour logo, and then proceed to the following tour

※**Mentaiko Museum** : Is a special museum dedicated to Hakata's unique culinary culture and history, which is curated by Mentaiko's old restaurant, Aji no Mentaiko 'Fukuya' .

※**Sake Sake Brewery Tour** : Nadagogo is a world-renowned sake producer and home to many famous sake breweries from Kobe to Nishinomiya. Sake brewed with the mineral-rich Miyamizu groundwater has a strong flavour and aroma, and it is said that 80% of the sake produced in Edo comes from Miyamizu.

※**Genkai Chunghwa Street - Sannomiya Trend District** : For a taste of Kobe's fashion, history and culture, start by exploring the bustling centre of Sannomiya. It's a popular shopping destination for young people, with a wide range of trendy clothing, grocery and cosmetic shops. Then, stroll through the nostalgic shopping street of Motomachi, where you can experience the western-style architecture of the Meiji era and find unique design items in the boutiques.

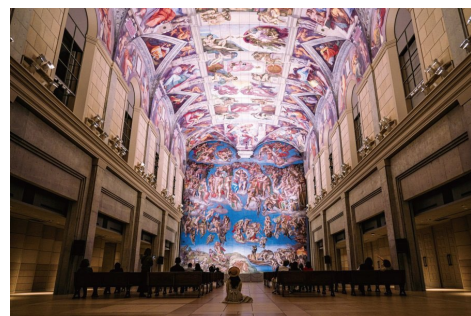

DAY 3 Kobe-Awaji Island-Takamatsu

※**Kobe Kitano Gekkeikan Street (optional)** : Kobe Kitano Gekkeikan is a foreign settlement that was formed after the opening of the port of Kobe in 1868. Located on a hill overlooking the sea, the townscape is a mixture of European and American style houses and traditional Japanese houses.

※**Awaji Island Highland Colourful Flower Field** : Awaji Hana Sajiki is a 15-hectare park located in the northern hills of Awaji Island in Hyogo Prefecture. The vast hinterland of the park is filled with flowers of various colours, and is a world of colourful blossoms throughout the year. (The view from the park's observation deck is particularly stunning.

※**Otsuka Museum (if closed, go to Reizanji Temple in Shikoku Hachijusho)** : The museum is the world's first ceramic art museum with Japan's largest permanent exhibition space and reproductions of world famous paintings on ceramic plates of the same size as the original paintings.

DAY 4 Takamatsu-Tokushima-Kotohira

※**Kuribayashi Park** : It is the largest park among all the gardens designated as cultural properties in Japan.

※**Naruto no Toshinomichi** : Toshinomichi is a 450-metre-long marine walkway underneath the carriageway of the Great Naruto Bridge. and is said to be the largest in the world, with a diameter of 20 metres.

※**Awa Dance Hall (Awa Dance Dance Dance Plateau Hands-On Trial is available upon request.)** : This is a facility where you can experience the Awa Dance and enjoy the world-famous Awa Dance of Tokushima all year round. 5th floor, there is an aerial ropeway station to the top of Meiyama, the symbol of the city of Tokushima.

DAY 5 Kotohira-Omu Danger-Kochi

※**Oyuhiku Tour Boat** : Take a cruise on the Yoshino River, gliding through the valley while enjoying the spectacular views of nature's handiwork, and get up close and personal with the marble-carved rocks that rise up on either side of the boat.

※**Zugu Kudzu Bridge** : The body of the bridge is made of wild climbing stems from the valleys, which were used for living purposes. It is now one of the three most famous bridges in Japan.

※**Kadono Park** : Kadono Park in Kagami City is one of the top 100 cherry blossom viewing spots in Japan, with more than 600 cherry blossom trees of various species forming a 200-metre-long tunnel.

At night, the park is illuminated with lanterns, allowing visitors to enjoy the beauty of the pink and soft white cherry blossoms glowing in the firelight.

※**Kochi Castle** : Kochi Castle was the feudal hall of the Tosa Clan during the Edo period. Kochi Castle is one of Japan's historical sites and has been selected as one of Japan's 100 most famous castles.

※**Katsushika Park - Sakamoto Ryoma Memorial Bronze Statue** : Katsushika Park is located on the coastline of Kochi City. The bow-shaped coastline and the blue Pacific Ocean reflect each other in a beautiful landscape, which has been known as a famous spot for moon-viewing since ancient times and is regarded as a representative attraction of Kochi Prefecture.

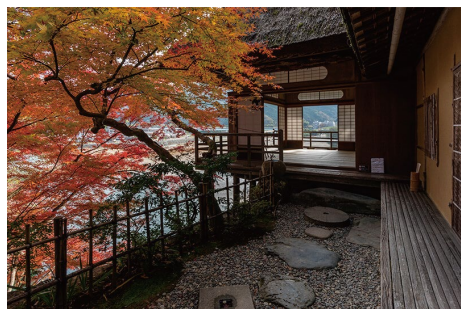

DAY 6 Kochi-Wolongsanso-Matsuyama

※**Wol Ryu Sanso** : The Wol Ryu Sanso garden is an ‘overlook garden’ built on the cliffs adjacent to the Brachyura River to take advantage of its excellent view.

※**Matsuyama Castle (take the sightseeing crane)** : Shiroyama Park as a whole is designated as a National Historic Site, and 21 buildings, including Hori, are designated as Important Cultural Properties. The castle is famous for its night view of the city and is one of the best places for cherry blossom viewing.

※**Three Great Ancient Springs Dogo Onsen** : Located in Matsuyama City, a castle town in Matsuyama Castle, Dogo Onsen is one of Japan’s three great ancient springs, with a history of more than 3,000 years, and is known for its two myths, ‘The Legend of the White Egret’ and ‘The Stone of Jade’.

DAY 7 Matsuyama-Imabari- Shinjuhama-Parents' Hama-Takamatsu

※**Imabari Museum of Art** : The Imabari Museum of Art was founded by the towel manufacturer Ichihiko Jukka, and it has a variety of displays that change the image of towels by combining towels with a variety of brands, characters, and so on, to create a number of amazing artefacts.

※**Besshi Copper Mine Memorial Hall** : This facility was built to convey the significance of the Besshi Copper Mine, the cornerstone of Niihama City. The city’s most famous azalea spot colours the roof of the museum red in May

※**Niihama Mega AEON Mall** : Aeon Mall is a famous shopping centre in Japan, where you can shop at supermarkets, fashion brand shops, and drugstores, or enjoy a meal at delicious restaurants and cafes.

※**Parent’s Beach Mirror of the Sky** : Not only has it been selected as one of the ‘100 Views of the Setting Sun in Japan’, but it also has a view of the mirror of the sky on the shores of the Salar de Uyuni in Bolivia, South America.

DAY 8 Takamatsu-Kodojima

※**Kodoshima Olive Park** : Kodoshima Olive Park is located on Kodoshima Island in Kagawa Prefecture and is a famous tourist spot in the Seto Inland Sea Islands. Kodo Island is the largest olive producer in Japan, and is known as ‘Olive Island’ because of the many beautiful olive trees that have been cultivated on the island for over a century. It is also famous as a filming location for ‘The Witch’s House’



※**Hankasai Sightseeing Cable Car** : The Hankasai Cable Car is a cable car that runs over Hankasai, one of Japan's three most beautiful valleys and a representative scenic spot of Seto Inland Sea National Park. You can enjoy the deep beauty of the valley, the colours of the plants in all seasons, and the sea view of the Seto Inland Sea while enjoying a walk in the air.

If you can't go there, you can go to Kodoshima Monster Museum instead.

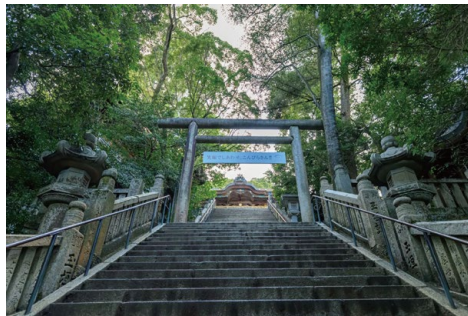

※**Kanebira Shrine** : This shrine is located in Kotohira-machi, Nakadodo-gun, Kagawa Prefecture, Japan, and is known as Kanebira Shrine, or Kotohira Shrine, which is pronounced the same way in Japanese. The old name of the shrine is Kokonin Nakasha (国幣中社).

※**Millennium Story/Iyonada Story Gourmet Train** : The 'Millennium Story Sightseeing Train' in Shikoku, Japan, is an unforgettable experience with breathtaking mountains and rivers, and a unique experience of beautiful scenery and gourmet food.
