DAY 1 Go to LA Airport and fly directly to Helsinki, the capital of Finland

Take an international flight from Los Angeles to Helsinki, the capital of Finland.

Overnight on board, adjust to jet lag and prepare for the next day's travels

DAY 2 Los Angeles-Helsinki

Arrive in Helsinki, the capital of Finland.

**Helsinki Cathedral: The white church stands on the Parliament Square, and the light green dome contrasts with the blue sky, which can be regarded as the essence of Finnish architectural art.

<u>** Uspensky Cathedral (exterior)</u>: The largest Russian Orthodox church in Northern Europe, designed by Russian architects and completed in 1868. The golden green dome and red brick walls are very eye-catching, and the colors and styles are full of mysterious colors.

**Senate Square: The political, religious, scientific and commercial center of Helsinki. The center of the square is the bronze statue of Tsar Alexander II, which was sculpted in 1894 to commemorate his granting of full autonomy to Finland. Three masterpieces of the master architect Engel can be seen on the Parliament Square: the cathedral, the government building and the University of Helsinki.

DAY 3 Helsinki-Tallinn-Stockholm


**Tallinn Old Town: It is a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site, with complete medieval walls and streets, rich historical culture and unique Nordic style.

* Tallinn Town Hall (exterior) preserved from the Middle Ages: built in the early 14th century, located in the Town Hall Square (also known as Lakoya Square) in the Old Town of Tallinn, this is the only Gothic town hall in the Baltic countries. Tallinn Town Hall is Tallinn's late Gothic town hall and is considered to be a unique and historic architectural treasure in Estonia.

*Tallinn Old City Wall (exterior): The ancient city wall of Tallinn Old Town is 2 kilometers long. Feel how the soldiers who guarded the city resisted foreign enemies. You can also see the ancient morning in Tallinn Old Town. The part of the old city wall currently open to the public connects the Nuna, Sauna and Kurdjala towers together.

**Alexander Nevsky Cathedral (exterior): Located on Toompea Hill, it is named after Alexander Nevsky, who fought against the invasion of the Teutonic Knights in the 13th century. It is a typical Russian style with a conspicuous "onion head" shape.

DAY 4 Stockholm-Orebro

**Stockholm City Hall: (entry includes official tour guide explanation) Located on the shore of Lake Mälaren in the center of the Swedish capital, it is the image and representative of Stockholm and the office of the city council.

*Medieval Vasa Museum (enter): A museum dedicated to exhibiting a Vasa shipwreck salvaged from the seabed. The Vasa is the only well-preserved 17th-century ship in the world.
*Stockholm Palace (exterior): This is currently the largest royal palace in the world. The first building on the current site of the palace was a castle built in the 13th century with a tower as the center.

★Stockholm Old Town: Founded in the 13th century, it has a history of more than 700 years. The city has medieval alleys, cobblestone streets and ancient buildings, which are deeply influenced by the

North Germanic style.

* Drottningholm Island: Because the construction of Drottningholm Island was inspired by the Palace of Versailles, it is also called "Versailles of Sweden".

DAY 5 Orebro, Sweden-Oslo

*Akershus Castle (exterior): built seven hundred years ago. From here you can overlook the fjord. This castle building that stretches out from the sea is one of the most representative buildings in the Middle

Wigeland Sculpture Park (enter): There are 169 sculptures and more than 700 stone sculptures of people. which vividly show the various periods of human life from birth to death, so it is also called the "Life Journey Park". •

**Oslo Royal Palace (exterior): It is where the Norwegian monarch handles daily affairs, and also holds

state meetings, holds state banquets, and entertains foreign leaders.

**Karl Johan Street: Norwegians call it the gateway to Oslo, where you can fully experience the customs, political pulse, and commercial and cultural characteristics of Norway. It is the main commercial street in Oslo.

DAY 6 Oslo-Geilo-Eidfjord

Eidfjord is a small town located at the end of Eidfjord, a branch of Hardangerfjord. Hardangerjøkulen, Måbødalen Village and Vøringfossen nearby, making this fjord town a tourist town in Hardangerfjord. There are many restaurants and hotels in the town, which is very lively *Geilois a ski resort town in the municipality of Hall, Buskerud County, Norway. Geilo is a ski resort in Norway. When winter is over, other sports activities are available including paintball, rafting, racing, golf, tennis, and cycling.

DAY 7 Eidfjord-Hartangefjord

**Hartangefjord:Mount Loien is 320 meters above sea level. Standing on the observation deck on the top of the mountain, you can have a panoramic view of the charming and beautiful Bergen in the embrace of the mountains and fjords.

XVollings Falls: Vollings Falls is 183 meters high, with a direct drop of 145 meters. In the snow melting season. The waterfalls are cascading and majestic, winding through the mountains and ravines,

and rushing down from such a high plateau. It is really a spectacle.

***Specialty Farms in Hardangerfjord:** the farms on both sides of Hardangerfjord are the northernmost fruit production areas in the world. (The farm will be adjusted according to different seasons and different hotel locations)

**Salmon fishery Learn how salmon production is carried out in practice, what are the benefits of producing salmon in Hardangerfjord, and have an in-depth understanding of modern salmon production.

DAY 8 Flam-Songnefjord-skei

**Sognefjord: Located in the center of the country of fjords, flowing through many glaciers and mountains, it is a beautiful tourist attraction. It is a member of the United Nations World Heritage List.

*The town of Flam: because this small village is the starting station of the mountain train "Flam Railway". From here, you can enjoy the most distinctive landscape. The whole village reflects the perfect integration of man and nature.

***Fjord Sightseeing Train**: Flam Railway is the highlight of Norway in miniature. This train is the steepest journey of ordinary freight tracks in the world and is also Norway's famous No. 1 tourist attraction.

**Nærøyfjord [World Heritage, Car Tour]: The name of Nærøyfjord comes from the Norse sea god "Njord". It is the most charming branch of the 204-kilometer-long Sognefjord and is also rated as one of the most beautiful fjords in the world. It was listed in the World Natural Heritage List in 2005.

DAY 9 Skei-Geiranger Fjord Geiranger-Lillehammer

****Geiranger Fjord:** It is a branch of the Storfjord, 15 kilometers long, and was listed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 2005.

**Geiranger Fjord Cruise: Cruise the fjord, and the mountains on both sides are beautiful and magnificent. Every summer, the famous Seven Sisters Waterfall is majestic, split into seven water columns and rush down, allowing you to feel the wonders of nature again.

*Dalsnibba Observation Deck: It is the most famous attraction in the area. You can experience the quiet and primitive nature, fresh air, and stunning scenery.

****Fjerbacka:** When the famous Swedish actress Ingrid Bergman returned to Sweden from abroad, Fjerbacka Dinglevägen was her favorite resting place.

****Gothenburg City Tour:** Haga is a historic district in Gothenburg, Sweden, attracting a large number of tourists with its well-preserved wooden houses and unique ancient atmosphere. After careful restoration, it has now become a vibrant and charming tourist destination.

Every corridor and every window may be the place where Hamlet wanders and meditates.

****openhagen City Tour:** It was once selected by the United Nations Human Settlements Program as the "most livable city in the world" and rated as the "best designed city".

**Amalienborg (exterior): It was built in the 18th century and is the main palace of the royal family. The royal palace is located around the octagonal square and consists of four identical palaces. If you have the chance, you can also see the royal guards with tall hats in Andersen's fairy tales.

*Nyhavn: Strolling along the canal full of moored wooden boats and colorful houses, you will feel like you are in a Danish fairy tale.

****Gothenburg:** It is the second largest city in Sweden and the headquarters of many companies such as Volvo and Maersk.
