## DAY 1 USA International flight to Seoul, South Korea

DAY 3 Bukchon Hanok Village – Insadong – Hotel Rest





Bukchon Hanok Village: Located north of Cheonggyecheon and Jongno, it is known
as "Bukchon", which was famous in the past for the high-end residential area where
many high-ranking royal officials or royal families lived, and still completely
preserved the buildings of the upper class in the past

Insadong: The lively Insadong is a characteristic street of Seoul. Between the alleys
on both sides of the road, there are many traditional tea houses and traditional craft
shops, where you can enjoy antiques or buy antique art in traditional shops and
discover traditional Korean culture.

DAY 4 TO SEOUL STATION TAKE KTX - SEASIDE TRAIN - BUSAN X THE SKY - HAEUNDAE WALK - THE BAY 101 NIGHT VIEW





- Busan X THE SKY Lookout: Located on the 98~100th floor at the top of the LCT
  Landmark Tower, Haeundae, the second tallest tower in Korea (411.6m), it occupies
  a total height of 3 floors. Here you can enjoy the view of the ocean of Haeundae and
  the beautiful city of Busan. The interior of the observation deck features a gorgeous
  media façade, a lounge, a café, and more.
- Haeundae Seaside Walk: A famous tourist spot in Busan in southern Korea. It is in Shuiying Bay on the southeast coast, about 18 kilometers northeast of Busan.
   Originally a hilly area that protrudes from the sea, it was built at the end of the Silla period and the sand dunes were developed. The water is clear, and the baths are famous all over the country with the nearby Dongguan Hot Springs. Tourist facilities are built along the coast. One of the Eight Scenic Spots in Korea.
- THE BAY 101: A complex leisure art space located in Haeundae District, which
  attracts many tourists because of its dazzling night view of Busan, and because it
  can also take beautiful photos of the water reflection, it has become a popular night
  scene shooting spot for Internet celebrities and young friends

DAY 5 Gamcheon-dong Cultural Village - BIFF Square - Jagalchi Seafood Market - Nampo-dong - KTX Back to Seoul - Dongdaemun Design Plaza





- Gamcheon-dong Cultural Village: Known as the "Santorini of Busan", it is a colorful village halfway up the mountain. Once a broken gong slum, it has become a wellknown cultural attraction under the impetus of the Busan "Hutong Art Project".
- BIFF Square: BIFF Square is located in Cinema Street, Nampo-dong, Busan, which was revitalized with the Busan International Film Festival in 1996 and was named BIFF Square. From the former "Fu Wing Theater" of Nampo-dong to the Land Bridge in Chungmu-dong, this section of the road is divided into two parts: "Star Street" and "Film Festival Street". Every year on the day before the Busan International Film Festival, celebrations are held here in advance, and many famous filmmakers come to participate in the "Commemorative Handprint" and "Snowflake Lighting" events. It can be described as a comprehensive leisure and entertainment space integrating "shopping, movies, and entertainment."
- Zhagachi Seafood Market: Located on the seaside of Nampodong, Gaschi Market is the most famous seafood market in Busan, with a history of more than 50 years, it is a large indoor market that includes seafood wholesale, retail and seafood outlets. The underground is an open fishing market with more than 300 seafood shops; On the second floor, there is a restaurant, where diners can buy seafood on the ground floor and find a restaurant cooker, or directly place an order at the restaurant, the price of the two is similar. On the other side of the second floor is a concentration selling dried seafood such as dried fish, dried shrimp, and dried kelp. On the third floor is the staff cafeteria, which is mainly Korean–style set meals, which are cheap and welcome non–employees. The Jagalchi Cultural Tourism Festival, which is held every October, is an annual event, and it is even more flavorful to come here during the festival.

- Nampo-dong: Nampo-dong Street is densely packed with theaters, and during the Busan International Film Festival, this movie street becomes the center stage for crowds. To commemorate the festival, PIFF (Busan International Film Festival) square was built on Nam Podong Street, and every year the copper plate engraved with the palm and footprints of the winner and the name of the winning work will be set on the ground of the square.
- Dongdaemun Design Plaza: Dongdaemun Design Plaza, which is quite eye-catching
  from the outside, is one of the most beautiful places in Seoul with night view. At
  night, the curved special buildings and the lights of the surrounding shopping malls
  are even more gorgeous. There are large shopping malls and small shops nearby.

DAY 6 Namsan Seoul Tower – Paju Imjingak – Freedom Bridge – Wangbai Wall
 Cheonggyecheon – Ginseng Specialty Store





- Namsan Seoul Tower: Climb to [Namsan Park] by cable car is the location of Seoul's landmark N Namsan Seoul Tower, with a "roof terrace" with love locks and tens of thousands of love locks, which is a representative love spot in Korea.
- War Reservations: Imjingak, Freedom Bridge, and Wangbai Altar are Korean representative sightseeing spots where visitors can experience the importance of peace.
- Imjingak is the place where exchanges between the North and the South are most frequent and active, and it is the most popular tourist spot in Gyeonggi Province for foreign tourists

- Cheonggyecheon River: Take a walk in Cheonggyecheon and enjoy walking while
  listening to the sound of running water. There is also a Eight Stone Lake, where
  tourists or citizens can throw coins and make wishes, and feel different experiences.
  With a total length of 5.8 kilometers, it is a miracle of the Han River, and it is an
  iconic river popular with tourists and locals alike
- Ginseng specialty store: Korean ginseng is undoubtedly synonymous with ginseng.
   The famous medical books of the Liang Dynasty in China also record that "the best of ginseng was produced in Korea".

DAY 7 Gyeongbokgung Palace – Blue House – Hallyu Cosmetics Store – Graffiti Show – Myeongdong





- Gyeongbokgung Palace: As the first palace of the Joseon Dynasty (the palace where the king lived), its largest features are the vast palaces and orderly buildings. It is the largest palace with the most beautiful architectural design. Arrange VIP experience Hanbok here and make good memories
- Blue House: The Blue House is the presidential palace of South Korea, and in the
  past, the Blue House as the residence space of the president of South Korea has
  always been a place of curiosity. Now, 74 years later, the enigmatic Blue House has
  finally opened to the public. The main building is backed by the Beiyue Mountain,
  and the tiles and the curved production roof are very beautiful.
