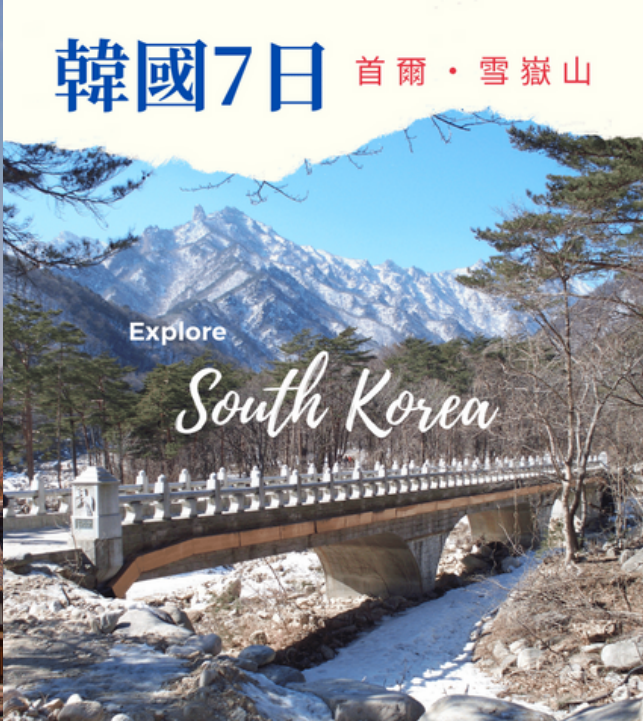

DAY 1 USA International flight to Seoul, South Korea

DAY 2 Arrive in Seoul in the evening–Bukchon Hanok Village – Insadong – go to the hotel to rest



- The flight arrived in Korea around this evening, where it was greeted by a professional guide and taken to Bukchon Hanok Village: Located north of Cheonggyecheon and Jongno, it is known as "Bukchon", which was famous in the past for being a high-end residential area where many high-ranking royal officials or royal families lived, and still completely preserved the construction of the upper class in the past
- Insadong: The lively Insadong is a characteristic street of Seoul. Between the alleys on both sides of the road, there are many traditional tea houses and traditional craft shops, where you can enjoy antiques or buy antique art in traditional shops and discover traditional Korean culture.

DAY 3 Yiwang Railway Bike – Jiufeng Mountain Observation Deck* Drinks – Yiyang Lake Skywalk



- Jiubongshan Observation Deck: In Chuncheon City, which has many mountains and lakes, Jiubongsan Mountain, which is less than 500 meters above sea level, is not high, but it is one of the best places to enjoy the night view of Chuncheon, and even if you don't climb to the very top of the mountain, you can still enjoy the beautiful scenery of Chuncheon from the mountainside. Jiufeng Mountain Observatory Coffee Street has a representative observation deck modeled after a building in Santorini, and the vast green grass is very suitable for weddings. There are also several good cafes or rest stops nearby, where you can order a cup of coffee and have a pleasant afternoon tea with family and friends.
- Yiyianhu Skywalk: With a total length of 190 meters, the Yiyianhu Skywalk is the longest skywalk in Korea. The Skywalk is built in Lake Yiyian and connects to the fish-shaped sculptures in the lake. The glass pavement is a new attraction in Chuncheon after attractions such as Nami Island.

DAY 4 Seoraksan National Park – Kwon Geumseong Cable Car – Sokcho Central Market – Nami Island



- Seoraksan National Park: The Seoraksan National Park Scenic Area is known as Snow Mountain and Snow Peak Mountain, and because the snow does not melt for many years, the rocks are white like snow, so it is called Seorake. Seoraksan National Park was designated as a Natural Monument Reserve in November 1965, a park reserve in December 1973, and a Biosphere Reserve by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) in August 1982. It is internationally famous for its picturesque scenery and breathtaking maple and waterfall landscapes, making visiting this place like stepping into a calendar of landscapes. The four seasons here are different, from the flowers in the spring, the clear stream in summer, the fire of the maple in autumn, and the snow-white granite nature of the mountain.

- **Quan Jincheng Cha:** Quan Jincheng is an ancient city site located in the steep mountain in the small park of Seoraksan Mountain, also known as Seoraksan Castle, Yongjinshan Castle, and Tutucheng. It is generally believed that it was built in 1253, the 23rd king of Goryeo (918~1392), when he was 40 years old (1213~1259). Since legend has it that the city was built by two generals surnamed Kwon and Kim to avoid war, it was called Kwon Kim Castle. The Feilong Bridge in the valley to the left of the small park can be walked to Kwon Kim Seong, but it takes more than 1 hour to walk the steep rocky road (2.5 km), so you can take the cable car to go up. The highest point of Kwon Geum–jo Castle is a rock, a lost platform, and a bell platform, and there are 80 places overlooking the East Sea and Sokcho City. In the west, there are strange rocks of various forms in the Xueyue Mountains such as Dinosaur Ridge, Tianhuatai, Majieling, and Zhuxiangling.
- **Sokcho Central Market:** Located in the Seongnam–dong area of Gangneung, Central Market officially opened on January 18, 1980, and together with the eastern market and western market of Gangneung, it forms the three traditional markets of Gangneung. The market is filled with general market merchants, livestock associations, agricultural cooperative supermarkets, individual businesses, shops, and entertainment bars, while roadside stalls stretch out along alleys and roads, auctioning off various regional specialties throughout the year.
- **Nami Island:** Nam Yi Island is a must–visit attraction on Nami Island, which is also the most frequently used scene in TV dramas, movies and commercials. Take a cruise on the lake and enjoy the romantic and beautiful scenery of the island.

DAY 5 Namsan Seoul Tower – Paju Imjingak – Freedom Bridge – Wangbai Wall – Cheonggyecheon – Ginseng Specialty Store



- Namsan Seoul Tower: Climb to [Namsan Park] by cable car is the location of Seoul's landmark Namsan Seoul Tower, with a "roof terrace" with love locks and tens of thousands of love locks, which is a representative love spot in Korea.
- War Reservations: Imjingak, Freedom Bridge, and Wangbai Altar are Korean representative sightseeing spots where visitors can experience the importance of peace.
- Imjingak is the place where exchanges between the North and the South are most frequent and active, and it is the most popular tourist spot in Gyeonggi Province for foreign tourists
- Cheonggyecheon River: Take a walk in Cheonggyecheon and enjoy walking while listening to the sound of running water. There is also a Eight Stone Lake, where tourists or citizens can throw coins and make wishes, and feel different experiences. With a total length of 5.8 kilometers, it is a miracle of the Han River, and it is an iconic river popular with tourists and locals alike
- Ginseng specialty store: Korean ginseng is undoubtedly synonymous with ginseng. The famous medical books of the Liang Dynasty in China also record that "the best of ginseng was produced in Korea".

DAY 6 Gyeongbokgung Palace – Blue House – Hallyu Cosmetics Store – Graffiti Show – Myeongdong



- Gyeongbokgung Palace: As the first palace of the Joseon Dynasty (the palace where the king lived), its largest features are the vast palaces and orderly buildings. It is the largest palace with the most beautiful architectural design. Arrange VIP experience Hanbok here and make good memories
- Blue House: The Blue House is the presidential palace of South Korea, and in the past, the Blue House as the residence space of the president of South Korea has always been a place of curiosity. Now, 74 years later, the enigmatic Blue House has finally opened to the public.

The main building is backed by the Beiyue Mountain, and the tiles and the curved production roof are very beautiful.

- Graffiti Show: The No. 1 Korean Graffiti Show for Three Consecutive Years · Use 3D stereoscopic projection technology to present the paintings, giving you a visual feast of amazement · Whether it is sketching, oil painting, sand painting, light sculpture, dazzling color, luminous painting can be seen. Inter-language performance, you can integrate without knowing Korean
- Myeongdong: Myeongdong is a shopping paradise with its unique charm that attracts crowds. It is most popular with young people in their 20~30s as well as foreign tourists.
