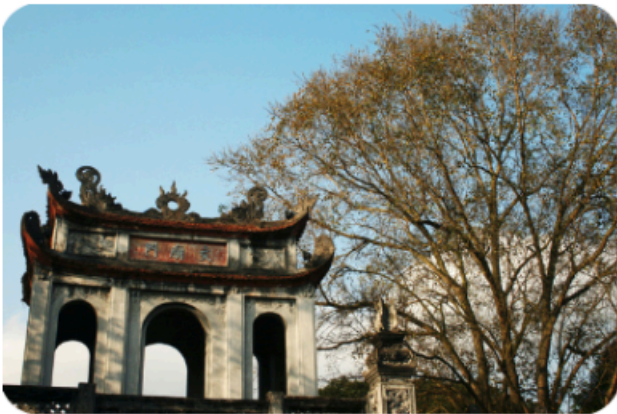
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DAY 1 Fly internationally to Vietnam



DAY 2 Arrival at Hanoi Airport, Vietnam – North Vietnam Hanoi City Tour



- The flight arrived in Vietnam today and was picked up by private car to start the tour of Vietnam
- Ba Dinh Square: Ba Dinh Square can be said to be the heart of Hanoi and a place where the people of Hanoi meet and play a role in festivals
- Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum: In addition to visiting historical monuments in Vietnam, "Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum" is also a must-see attraction!
- Doge's Palace (exterior): Also known as the President's Palace, a yellow French-style building built in 1906
- Temple of Literature: Hanoi's best preserved and most beautiful monument, allowing you to experience first-hand the ancient history of Vietnam and its indelible relationship with Chinese culture
- Hoan Kiem Lake: Located in the heart of the city, surrounded by the downtown area of Hanoi City, the lake is full of green grass, clear and beautiful
- Sanjuku Street: A quaint traditional shopping street, each narrow street is named after the goods traded at that time, such as Silk Street, Rice Street, Paper Street, Jewelry Street, etc., a total of 36, stroll here to enjoy French romance

DAY 3 Hanoi – Halong Bay Cruise – Cruise Tour



- Head to the Kiosk B135 Ambassador Lounge, check in and start your cruise in Hanoi's Halong Bay, designated a World Heritage Site by UNESCO on 17 December 1994, where you can enjoy a buffet lunch as the Ambassador Cruise passes through thousands of majestic limestone islets in Halong Bay.
- Dong Xiu Pearl Farm: Dedicated to growing pearls and practicing Japanese techniques based on Vietnamese traditions and traditional handmade techniques.
- Titov Island: Here you can swim or climb to the top and enjoy the vastness and magnificence of Halong Bay from 100 meters high.
- Enjoy a cooking class or happy hour in the piano lounge or on the sundeck (depending on weather conditions).
- For dinner, enjoy a gourmet dinner with the chef's special menu at the restaurant. (Dress code: formal/semi-formal/business casual)

DAY 4 Explore Sung Sot Surprise Cave – Disembark – 36 Ancient Streets Afternoon Tea



- Start your day with a session of Tai Chi on the sundeck or piano lounge in the morning (weather conditions)
- Cave of Surprise: The largest and most spectacular cave in the bay, the most beautiful limestone cave in Halong Bay. A wonderful and mysterious thousand-year-old stalactite with various unique forms. The natural fantasy cave is full of surprises as its name suggests, and a must-visit attraction on a

classic boat trip

- After breakfast, check out and disembark and be picked up by private car back to Hanoi for afternoon tea (one cup of coffee and small cake per person) in 36 ancient streets

DAY 5 Hanoi – West Lake – Tran Quoc Temple



- West Lake : West Lake is the largest lake and most famous scenic area in the capital of Hanoi, with a width of 500 hectares. Nearly 20 kilometers long, the road around the lake is an idyllic road that attracts tourists all year round.
- Zhen Quoc Temple: This temple is nearly 1500 years old and is considered to be the oldest temple in Thang Long – Hanoi. The architecture of the pagoda blends majesty, antiquity and elegance against a tranquil backdrop of an endless lake. Known for its sacred Buddhist gates, it attracts many Buddhist believers and tourists inside and outside Vietnam.

DAY 6 Hanoi Domestic Flight to Da Nang – Hoi An – Roaming Canaan Island – Hoi An



- Canaan Island: Located on the opposite bank of Hoi An, about 30 minutes by boat from Hoi An Pier, the Hoi An Chou Bon River, a river that originates from the border between Laos and Vietnam and crosses Vietnam. There are many shops on this side of Hoi An in the Qiubon River; On the other side,

Canaan Island, which is still undeveloped, is a relatively pristine natural landscape, and most of the islanders depend on fishing and wood carving. Let's experience riding a traditional bamboo barrel boat, passing through the pristine natural scenery, and experiencing crab fishing.

DAY 7 Hoi An – Da Nang – Take cable car to Ba Na Hills Day Trip



- Bana Hills (Cable Car Round-Trip): Take the world's longest, tallest, non-stop cable car to Mount Bana. There are woods and rocks and streams under your feet, and after 10 minutes, you are in the sea of clouds, and the foreground looks like you are in a fairyland, with beautiful terrain, known as "French Spring Mountain City". When the weather is clear, standing on the top of the main mountain, you can see Da Nang City, Yung Orange Bay, My Khe Hai, etc., the whole wide space is like a giant landscape painting
- Jingxin Garden (Little Train): Visit a hidden French cellar built by the French on the hill during the colonial period
- Buddha Hand Sky Trail: Enjoy unobstructed views of the Ba Na Hills. The trail is about 150 meters long, and the golden sky trail is lined with purple half of the lotus flowers, which is perfect for checking in and taking photos.
- FANTASY PARK: A COMPREHENSIVE ENTERTAINMENT THEME DIVIDED INTO THREE FLOORS, INCLUDING A VARIETY OF INDOOR GAMES, WHERE YOU CAN ENJOY ALL THE SERVICES IN THE PARK.
