DAY 1 | Depart USA-Hanoi(HAN)

DAY 2 | Arrival Hanoi(HAN)-West Lake-Tran Quoc Pagoda-Hotel

Arrive at Noi Bai International Airport (HAN), Hanoi.

West Lake-Also known historically as Kim Nguu Lake, Due Lake, Lang Bac, Dam Tan, and Fox Corpse Lake, West Lake is a famous lake located in the northwest of Hanoi, about 200 meters from Ba Dinh Square. Covering approximately 5 square kilometers, it is the largest natural lake in Hanoi. The horseshoe-shaped lake is a remnant of an ancient course of the Red River.

Tran Quoc Pagoda-With a history of over 2,000 years, Tran Quoc Pagoda is the oldest Buddhist temple in Vietnam, originally built in 541 AD. The pagoda enshrines both Buddhist and Taoist deities, with Buddhism as its primary focus. Its lakeside setting offers one of the best viewpoints to admire the sunset over West Lake.

DAY 3 | Hanoi-Lao Cai Province-Sapa-Sapa Church Square & Stone Church-Rong May Glass Bridge-Cat Cat Village

Travel from Hanoi to **Lao Cai Province** and onward to the mountain town of Sapa, one of the most beautiful highland destinations in Indochina. Known for its cool climate, breathtaking landscapes, European-style architecture, and rich ethnic culture, Sapa is often praised by Western travelers as a “paradise on earth.”

Sapa Church Square (Love Market)-The Sapa Stone Church was originally built in 1903 entirely of stone and is considered the highest-altitude church in Vietnam. The square in front of the church is known as the Love Market, once a traditional gathering place and now an important public square where locals and visitors relax and socialize, especially in the afternoons and evenings.

Sapa Stone Church (Centennial Church)-Constructed by the French in 1895, this historic church features a bell tower and Roman-Gothic architectural style, reflecting a harmonious blend of French and Vietnamese cultural influences.

Rong May Glass Bridge (Dragon in the Clouds Glass Bridge)-A spectacular skywalk rising to about 2,300 meters above sea level, offering 360-degree panoramic views of the Hoang Lien Son mountain range. Visitors can admire rolling clouds, dramatic peaks, and endless forested valleys, earning it the nickname “Gateway to Heaven above O Quy Ho Pass.”

Cat Cat Village-One of the most beautiful villages in Sapa, home to a scenic waterfall and picturesque landscapes. Known in French as CatScat, the village showcases traditional Hmong culture and charming mountain scenery.

DAY 4 | Muong Hoa Mountain Train-Fansipan Cable Car-One-way Incline Railway-Fansipan Peak-Ta Van Village

Muong Hoa Mountain Train-This scenic mountain railway connects Sapa town with the Fansipan Cable Car Station and stretches approximately 2 kilometers, making it the longest mountain train route in Vietnam. Departing from the MGallery Hotel in Sapa, the train journey offers spectacular views of the Hoang Lien Son mountain range along the way.

Fansipan Legend Cable Car-Conquer the Highest Peak in Indochina – Built by Sun Group, this world-record-holding triple-cable system is the longest of its kind in the world. It allows visitors to effortlessly ascend to Fansipan Peak (3,143 meters), the highest mountain in Vietnam and Indochina. Enjoy sweeping views of Sapa, the Hoang Lien Son Mountains, and the breathtaking Muong Hoa Valley.

Ta Van Village-Located about 10 kilometers from Sapa town in the Muong Hoa Valley, Ta Van Village is home to ethnic minority groups such as the Hmong, Red Dao, and Tay. The village features traditional stilt houses and offers insight into the authentic lifestyles and customs of local communities.

DAY 5 | Sapa-Halong Bay

Travel to **Halong Bay**, a spectacular natural wonder located in Quang Ninh Province in northern Vietnam. Known as one of the New Seven Natural Wonders of the World and often referred to as the “Guilin on the Sea,” Halong Bay features more than 3,600 limestone islands and islets scattered across nearly 4,000 square kilometers of emerald waters.

Along the journey, enjoy views of endless rice fields and scenic countryside landscapes. The bay is also home to numerous fascinating limestone caves adorned with stalactites and stalagmites. With its extraordinary beauty and geological significance, Halong Bay has been recognized as a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**.

DAY 6 | Halong Bay-Ambassador Cruise-Fighting Cocks Rock-Limestone Cave-Viewing Platform-Luon Cave-Titop Island

The island features three viewing platforms, each offering different perspectives of Halong Bay. For the ultimate experience, climb to the summit for a 360-degree panoramic view, where layers of limestone peaks stretch across the emerald waters and golden sunlight paints the bay in a magical glow.

DAY 7 | Halong Bay-Ambassador Cruise-Sung Sot (Surprise) Cave-Return to Hanoi (Afternoon Tea)

Begin the day with **Sung Sot Cave (Surprise Cave)**, a vast limestone cavern covering approximately 10,000 square meters. Inside, visitors can admire an incredible variety of stalactites, stalagmites, and limestone pillars, showcasing the raw power and artistry of nature. This cave is considered one of the most beautiful limestone caves in Halong Bay. In the early morning, as mist surrounds the peaks and valleys, the mountains appear like a classical ink-and-wash painting. Lucky guests may even witness a spectacular sunrise over the bay.

After the morning cruise, disembark and return to Hanoi, enjoying afternoon tea en route.

07:30/Visit Sung Sot Cave (Surprise Cave), the largest and most spectacular limestone cave in Halong Bay. Famous for its mysterious and magical beauty, the cave is filled with an array of crystal-clear stalactites and stalagmites in unique shapes.

08:30/Enjoy breakfast in the restaurant while the Ambassador Cruise departs for the pier.

09:30/Check out at the reception desk and settle any onboard charges.

10:15/Disembark at the pier and transfer by coach back to Hanoi, enjoying afternoon tea in the city.



DAY 8 | Hanoi-Ba Dinh Square-Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (Exterior)-Presidential Palace(Exterior) -One Pillar Pagoda-Hoan Kiem Lake-36 Ancient Streets-St. Joseph's Cathedral

Ba Dinh Square-If Hanoi is the heart of Vietnam, then Ba Dinh Square is its very center. Located in the heart of the city, it serves as a gathering place for public events and national celebrations.

Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (Exterior)-A square structure made of gray marble, the mausoleum reflects strong Soviet-era architectural influences and bears some resemblance to Lenin's Mausoleum in Moscow's Red Square. Note: Exterior viewing only; entry is not included.

Presidential Palace (Exterior)-Originally the Governor's Palace during French Indochina, constructed between 1900 and 1906. This yellow European-style building features wrought-iron gates, classical columns, and grand staircases. The only distinctly Vietnamese visual element is the mango tree in the courtyard. Note: Exterior viewing only; entry is not included.

One Pillar Pagoda-A unique and iconic pagoda built atop a single pillar, elegantly rising from a lotus pond. Though small, it is one of Vietnam's most representative ancient temples. Afterwards, visit the Temple of Literature, a thousand-year-old Confucian temple.

Hoan Kiem Lake-A natural freshwater lake located in central Hanoi, in the Hoan Kiem District. It is one of Hanoi's most famous landmarks and a popular spot for locals' daily leisure and recreation.

36 Ancient Streets-Dating back to the 15th century, each narrow street was historically named after the goods traded there, such as Silk Street, Rice Street, Paper Street, and Jewelry Street, totaling 36 streets.

St. Joseph's Cathedral-Also known as Saint Joseph Cathedral, it is the oldest church in Hanoi. Built in Gothic style and inspired by Paris' Notre Dame, it is a signature example of French architecture in the city. The main doors only open during Mass; visitors typically enter from the side entrances.

DAY 9 | Hanoi (Noi Bai)-Da Nang-Hoi An (Hoi An Ancient Town/Cam Kim Island Waterway Experience-Traditional Basket Boat & Crab Fishing Fun)

Hoi An Ancient Town-Travel to Hoi An, a historic port town rich in Chinese cultural influence, for today's exploration of this charming ancient city. Hoi An is located about 30 kilometers southeast of Da Nang along the Thu Bon River, near the South China Sea delta. During the Champa Kingdom era, it was a bustling trade hub connecting China, India, and Arabia. Its preserved architecture reflects a blend of historical influences, giving the old town a relaxed and picturesque charm reminiscent of Lijiang in Yunnan, China. In December 1999, Hoi An was designated as a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site.

Cam Kim Island Eco-Experience-Known as the "Pearl of the Thu Bon River," Cam Kim Island (Dao Cam Kim) is famous for its water coconut palms and pristine natural landscapes. Upon arrival, guests board traditional basket boats (coracle boats) and are guided by local fishermen through the island's scenic waterways, enjoying the idyllic riverside scenery and experiencing the relaxed rhythm of rural Vietnamese life.

DAY 10 | Hoi An-Da Nang-Ba Na Hills (French Village-Cable Cars-Mini Train-Golden Bridge & Hand-Fantasy Park-Return to Da Nang)

Ba Na Hills-Located 40 km west of Da Nang at an elevation of 1,487 meters, Ba Na Hills was a French colonial retreat as early as the 20th century. Guests ascend the mountain via a two-stage cable car journey. The first section holds the Guinness World Record (2009) for the longest and largest single-cable car lift. Starting from the first cable car station at the base, the ride reaches the second station at 1,330 meters, passing over forests and mountain streams. As you climb higher, mist and clouds surround you, giving the sensation of floating above the landscape. The route descends to visit the Big Buddha and Linh Ung Pagoda.

Ba Na Hills French Village-Resembling a medieval European town, the French Village transports visitors to a fairy-tale setting. From the cable car, enjoy panoramic views of endless forests, dense jungles, and cascading waterfalls, as if stepping into a living landscape painting.

Golden Bridge & Giant Hands-Situated at the Sun World Ba Na Hills Sky Garden at 1,414 meters above sea level, the Golden Bridge stretches nearly 150 meters across eight spans, supported by two enormous stone hands. This elegant bridge appears to float above the clouds, while the moss-covered hands evoke an ancient, nostalgic atmosphere. Designed as the hands of a mountain god, the structure symbolizes pulling a golden silk ribbon from the mountains to guide villagers to the heavenly gardens.

Fantasy Park Indoor Amusement Park-Boasting modern indoor attractions, visitors can experience thrilling rides such as free-fall towers, interactive 5D movies, climbing walls, and various family-friendly games, providing endless fun for children and adults alike.
