Daily itinerary

DAY 1 Fly internationally from the United States to Tokyo DAY 2 ARRIVED TODAY IN TOKYO, JAPAN - BOUND FOR KANAGAWA - YOKOHAMA MM21 Future Port

Fly from the United States to Tokyo Narita Airport, and then transfer to Kanagawa Prefecture upon arrival Minato Miku 21: Minatomirai Yokohama Minato 21 is a futuristic waterfront with an observation deck and a trendy boutique-filled Yokohama landmark building and plaza.

DAY 3 Kamakura Daibuddha (National Treasure) - Shonan Coast - Japanese Fish Cake Kobo Gakugaku - Izu Peninsula

National Treasure of Japan "Kamakura Great Buddha": The 13.35-meter-tall bronze Buddha statue was built in 1252 and is the deity statue enshrined in Kotoku-in, also known as "Hase Daiju". Certified as a National Treasure in 1958, the inside of the Buddha statue can be visited.

Shonan Coast: Located on the coast from Chigasaki City to Kamakura City in the Shonan area of Kanagawa Prefecture. Due to its beautiful scenery, the coastal area has become a famous surfing and dating mecca in Japan. Izu Peninsula: The Izu Peninsula in eastern Shizuoka Prefecture is not far from Tokyo and Kanagawa, and many people come to Tokyo to include the Izu Peninsula in their itinerary. The Izu Peninsula is of course famous for its hot springs, sea view, and Kawazu cherry blossoms! DAY 4 Izu - Kinosaki Coast "Sea View and Reef" Numazu Fish Market - Atamai Plum Garden Plum Festival (See nearly 730 red and white plum trees).

Kinosaki Coast: Ito, which is rich in ancient style and literati, is a representative of the scenery of the Izu Rock, and the coastline here is a typical volcanic lava terrain, which is 9 kilometers long, and is said to have been formed by lava from the eruption of Mount Omuro about 5,000 years ago.

Numazu Fish Market: Senhonko Town, Numazu City, Shizuoka Prefecture, Japan, is the third largest fish market in Japan, and every morning there is an auction of various "world's first fresh" food, and you can immediately enjoy delicious seafood with saturated color and excellent taste.

Atamai Plum Garden Plum Blossom Festival: Japan's oldest plum garden, built in Meiji 19, is located on a gentle hill, covering an area of 30,000 hectares, planted with more than 730 plum trees, the most famous being Yae Wild Plum, Winter Solstice Plum, Yae Kan Red, Kagoshima Red Plum and others. Every year in December, the plum blossoms are already in Turui, and from January to mid-March of the following year, it is in full bloom. DAY 5 Izu Kawazu Sakura Festival - Izu Nanataki - Mt. Izu (Scenic Cable Car) - Izu Coastal Train - Tokyo

Izu Kawazu Sakura Festival: "Kawazu Sakura" is a type of cherry blossom, named Kawazu cherry blossom because it is found in "Kawazu-cho, Kamo District, Shizuoka Prefecture", and is characterized by the fact that the blossom period is the earliest in Honshu, Japan, so it is also called "Japan's first cherry blossom", which is the earliest cherry blossom season that usually blooms in early spring, and there are 8,000 kawazu cherry blossoms in Kawazu Town, and the Kawazu cherry blossom season is held during the blooming time.

Izu Nanataki (Kawazu Seven Waterfalls): There are several waterfalls in the Kawazu area, among which the seven waterfalls are particularly famous, collectively known as "Kawazu Nanataki", which are "Kamataki", "Shrimp", "Snake Taki", "Hatsuketaki", "Crab Taki", "Dehopaki", "Otaki", and a total of seven waterfalls. Among them, Kamataki is 22 meters tall and has an observation deck where you can see the waterfall up close and even feel the splashing of water droplets.

Mt. Sleeper (Sightseeing Gondola): This mountain resembles the posture of a girl going to bed, so it is called Mt. Sleep. Cable car rides up to the summit of the mountain-Yotsuzan Nature Park (about 5 minutes) to see the majestic Amagi Mountains and Izu Seven Islands.

Izu Coastal Train: Take the train to Tokyo and enjoy the beautiful scenery of the Izu coastline along the way Breakfast: Hotel | Lunch: Izu Famous Kaneme Sea Break| Dinner: Frost Drop Wagyu Beef SHABU Hotel: Shinjuku Hilton Tokyo or Hyatt Regency Tokyo or similar

DAY 6 Asakusa Kaminji Temple - Nakami Sedondo Shopping Street - Imperial Palace Gaien Plaza -Futobashi - Tokyo - Return to the hotel for free time

Asakusa Kaminji Temple: <u>Sensoji Temple, the oldest temple in</u> Tokyo, is crowded with tourists, worshippers, and shopping, and is also a famous tourist spot in Tokyo. It is rumored that Sensoji Temple is very effective, so you may wish to give it a try if you have the opportunity

Imperial Palace Outer Garden Square: The Imperial Palace is the residence of the Emperor of Japan. The Imperial Palace was formerly a castle built by the Edo shogunate and was not the residence of the Emperor of Japan until 1888.

Futabashi: Located in front of the main entrance of the Imperial Palace. Since the moat around the Imperial Palace is deeper than the old bridge, it is necessary to build another bridge on the old bridge, hence the name "Duo Bridge". Breakfast: Hotel | Lunch: Seasonal Cuisine| Dinner: Optional

Hotel: Shinjuku Hilton Tokyo or Hyatt Regency Tokyo or similar

DAY 7 Free time in the morning - followed by shuttle to the airport - end the pleasant journey back to sweet home or transfer to the next journey
